**Murrumbidgee IVT limit** has been reached. Trade into the Murrumbidgee is now closed.

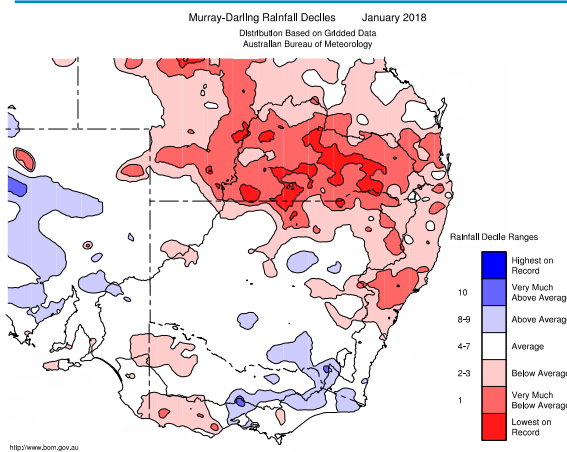
**Trade out of the Goulburn** remains closed.

**Temporary trade in and out of Lower Darling Regulated River** has closed.

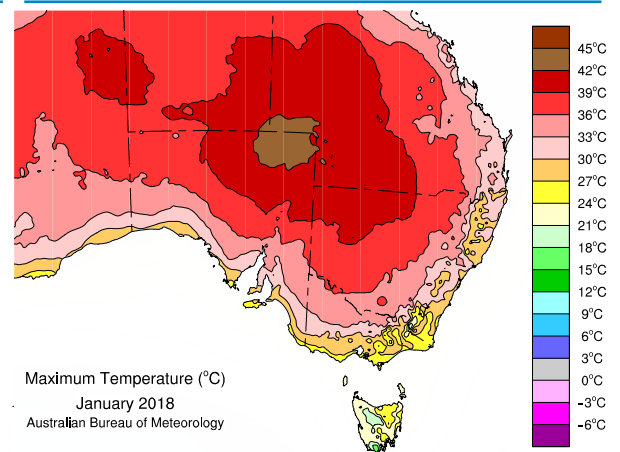
### WEATHER

**MEAN MAX TEMPERATURES JAN 2018**

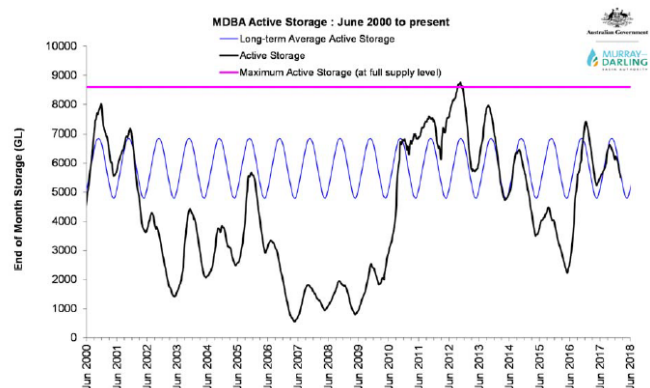


### MDB ACTIVE STORAGE

Following the summer trend, storage in the Murray Darling Basin has decreased over summer, in line with the long-term average.

Whilst high security water has been set aside for next season, without a significant rain event, general security/ low reliability entitlement may not receive additional allocation in the short term.
