SOUTHERN CONNECTED SYSTEM

Key Events

Namoi Water Restrictions Unchanged

Customers can extract water ordered on or before 5 November 2018.

Trade of GS allocations Lower Namoi remains closed.

15% restriction in the Upper Namoi lifted.

Lower Namoi GS water orders submitted after 5 November still cannot be accepted.

Next water allocation statement for the Namoi regulated river will be available early February 2019.

FORTNIGHTLY ALLOCATIONS

Next allocations for NSW and VIC will be announced on 15 January 2019.

WATER TRADING RESTRICTIONS

Murrumbidgee out-trade is still open - capacity for 97.6GL to be transferred out.

Murrumbidgee in-trade is closed - will re-open when the Murrumbidgee IVT account balance reaches 15GL (currently 2.4GL).

Goulburn out trade still closed as IVT account does not have a positive balance.

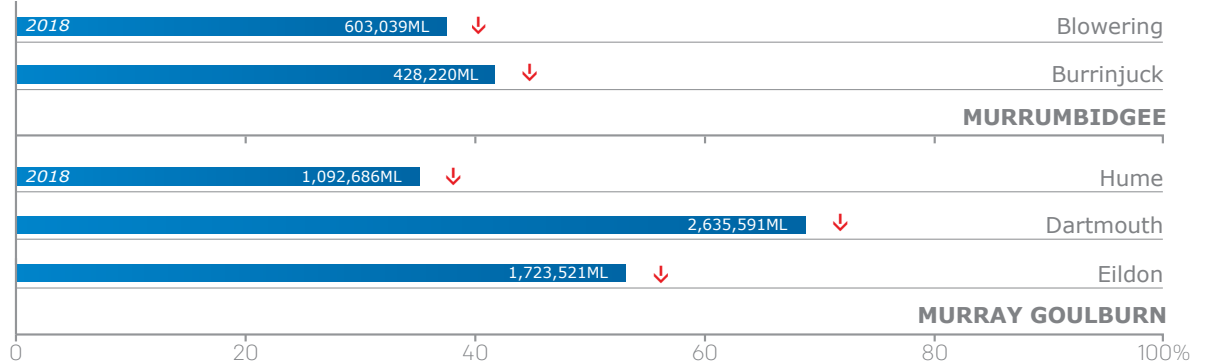
Goulburn in trade is still open.

The Barmah Choke remains open - current balance allowing 65,857ML to be traded.

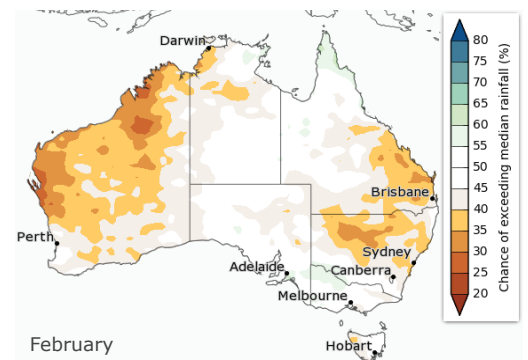
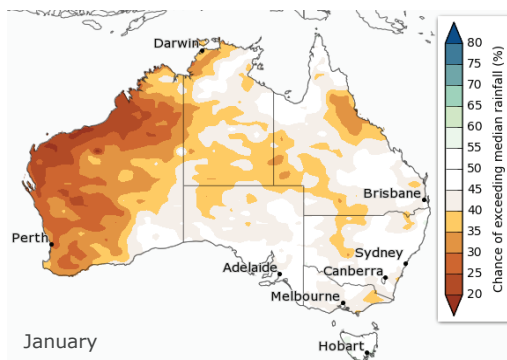
Trade from NSW to VIC is open - 266GL net trade currently allowed due risk of spill in the Murray still being below 50%.

Lower Darling Regulated River - Temporary trade in and out remains closed.

January to February 2019 outlooks indicate drier than average conditions for most of western WA, parts of the northern NT and eastern mainland.

The rest of the country shows no strong push towards a wetter or drier than average season.
