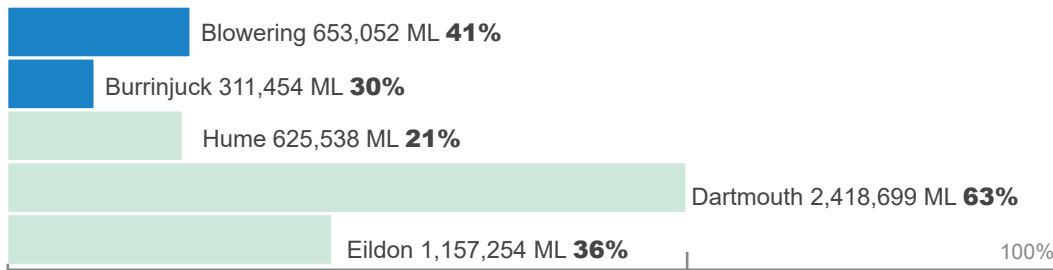
Water Trading Restrictions as of 2018/19 closure of markets

Goulburn to Murray IVT trade possible if water owed to the Murray system is less than 200GL. As at 28 June the balance was approx. 95GL, providing a trade opportunity of approx. 105GL. This may change with trade activity this week, and the final balance will carry forward to 1 July.

Murrumbidgee to Murray is open for Perm trade only with capacity for 76.3 GL to be transferred out of the Murrumbidgee valley.

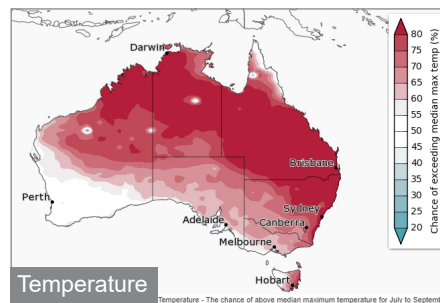
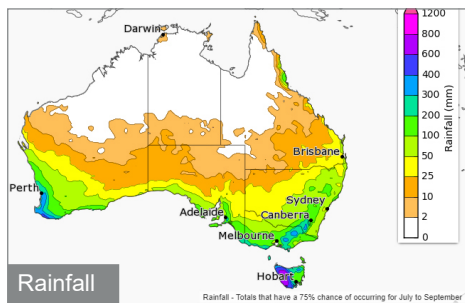
Murray to Murrumbidgee is open for Perm trade only with capacity for 23.7 GL to be transferred into the Murrumbidgee valley.

BOM Climate Outlook Overview for July - Sept 2019

July to September are likely to be warmer than average for most of Australia. Exceptions are in southern WA, parts of northern Queensland, western Tasmania and far southern mainland coasts. A drier than average three months is likely for large parts of the country, extending from the northern NT, through Queensland and NSW, and into Victoria and southeast SA. For July, the drier than average signal is confined to western WA, and central to eastern NSW extending up into southern Queensland.
