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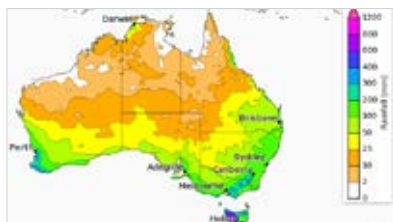
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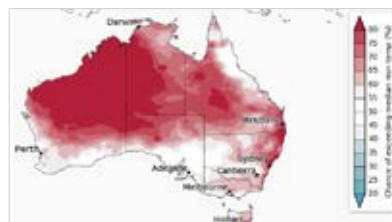
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### BOM Climate Outlook Overview for Aug - Oct 2019

A drier than average August to October is likely for large parts of the country, including much of eastern and northern Australia and parts of southwest WA and southern SA. The month of August is likely to be drier over the tropical north and extending down eastern Queensland and NSW into northern Victoria. Conversely, southeast WA is likely to be wetter than average, with the rest of the country having roughly equal chances of a wetter or drier than average month.



Rainfall - Totals that have a 50% chance of occurring for August to October



Temperature - Chance of above median minimum temperature for August to October.
